### Uniform

A Mighty Mites T-shirt is included with player registration. T-shirts are usually distributed at the first Mighty Mites session. Players should wear athletic shorts to every session (no cutoffs, cargo shorts, etc.)

All players must wear shin guards at all sessions. Players without shin guards will be required to sit out some or all of the session.

## Uniforms

- **Jersey:** The Recreation program uses reversible jerseys color-coded to the player's age group:
  - U6 boys and girls: red and white.
  - U7 and U8 boys: orange and white.
  - U7 and U8 girls: yellow and white.
  - U10 boys: royal blue and white.
  - U10 girls: purple and white.
  - Players may reuse jerseys from previous seasons as long as they are the right color for their age group.
- **Shorts:** Players are required to wear black soccer shorts. Shorts do not need to be any particular style or brand, but they do need to be black. Small white accents are OK.
- **Socks:** Players are required to wear tall, black socks that cover the shin guards. Socks do not need to be any particular style or brand, but they do need to be black. Small white accents are OK.
- **Adidas** is a valued partner of Idaho Rush and we strongly encourage players to use Adidas shorts and socks. Both are available in the Idaho Rush office.

### Cost

Jerseys are \$18.  
Shorts are \$11 for youth sizes, \$14 for adult sizes in the office.  
Soccer-specific socks are \$6-7 in the office. We also have generic tube socks for \$5.

### Where do I get a uniform?

Jerseys, shorts and socks are available year-round in the [Idaho Rush office](#).

Jerseys are also available for a few weeks running up to each season at [McU's Sports](#) in downtown Boise (342-7734). The cost is the same as in the office, \$18.

Shorts and socks are also available at sporting goods stores and most general retail stores (Fred Meyer, etc.).

### **What extra equipment and gear do I need?**

Players should bring a properly inflated ball to every training session and every game. The size of the ball is specific to the player's age group:

U6s, U7s and U8s: Size 3.

U10s: Size 4.

Cleats are allowed at all age groups but are not required.

All players must wear shin guards at all training sessions and games. Players without shin guards will be required to sit out some or all of the training session and all of the game.

### Uniform

**Jersey:** The Select program uses two jerseys, a white one and a blue one. Following the fall 2013 season, players may reuse Adidas jerseys from previous seasons.

**Shorts:** Players are required to wear the black Adidas soccer shorts sold as part of the full uniform.

**Socks:** Players are required to wear the black Adidas socks sold as part of the full uniform.

### Cost

Jerseys are \$19 each for youth sizes, \$22 each for adult sizes. Adidas shorts are \$11 for youth sizes and \$14 for adult sizes. Adidas socks are \$6-7.

### Where do I get a uniform?

The new Adidas uniforms will be ordered when you register online for the fall 2013 season. There will be a limited selection of uniforms available in the [Idaho Rush office](#) for players who lose pieces.

### What extra equipment and gear do I need?

Players should bring a properly inflated soccer ball to every training session and every game. The size of the ball is specific to the player's age group:

U8s: Size 3.

All players must wear shin guards at all training sessions and games. Players without shin guards will be required to sit out some or all of the session and all of the game.

### Numbers and logos

Jersey numbers are not used in the Select program in the U8 through U12 age groups.

In the U14 and High Schol age groups, jersey numbers are required. Teams should take jerseys without numbers to [McU's Sports](#) (342-7734) to have numbers applied at no cost to the player or team.

Jerseys are pre-printed with the club and/or title sponsor logos. Any additional logos (team sponsor, etc.) must be approved by [Idaho Rush](#).

Jerseys vary in cost based on size and current style, but generally range between \$40-43 each. For specific prices, contact your team manager or call the office (336-6512).

Shorts vary in cost based on size and current style, but generally range between \$16-18 each. For specific prices, contact your team manager or call the office (336-6512).

Socks are \$9 per pair. For specific prices, contact your team manager or call the office (336-6512).

Training shirts are \$7.50.

Orders for uniforms (and replacement parts) are placed individually with Eurosport using an online link you will receive from [custserve@sportsendeavors.com](mailto:custserve@sportsendeavors.com). Additional pieces are not immediately available during the year. Pieces must be ordered online and there will be additional shipping costs and delays.
